We are excited to announce the 23rd Season of Henry H. Stambaugh Youth Concert Band (SYCB). Auditions will be held for wind and percussion musicians at Stambaugh Auditorium on **Wednesday**, **September 4 from 5-9 pm** and **Tuesday**, **September 10 from 5-9 pm**. Stambaugh Auditorium provides this opportunity to work together with school band programs and band directors to give exceptional band musicians an opportunity to perform with other outstanding student musicians. Students must be a member in good standing of their respective high school band and be recommended by their high school band director. In cases of rehearsal/performance conflicts, the student will honor their obligation to their high school band first.

Rehearsals will be held in the Concert Hall at Stambaugh Auditorium. Students will participate in a full band setting in addition to possible woodwind choir, brass choir, and percussion ensembles. The band will be directed and conducted by Mr. Tyler Husosky, Dr. Kate Ferguson, and Mr. Nathan Sensabaugh.

Rehearsals will be held each Tuesday evening throughout the school year. A parent-student meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 17 at 6:00 pm in the Concert Hall at Stambaugh Auditorium prior to the first full rehearsal. The fall performance will take place on Tuesday, November 12, 2024. The spring performance will be on Tuesday, April 15, 2025. Both concerts will be open to an in-person audience as well as live-streamed on Stambaugh Auditorium's website. SYCB will also be participating in the Northeast Ohio Band Invitational at Severance Music Center on January 26, 2025. More information regarding this performance will be forthcoming. The opportunity for seniors to audition for senior soloist honors will be held in January. The awarded solo performance will be presented at the spring concert. *The Barbara Armstrong Youth Band Scholarship* will be presented to an outstanding senior student member at the April concert.

Information and Schedule

The Henry H. Stambaugh Youth Concert Band (SYCB) has been established to expand the musical education of band students. Percussion instruments, band music, music stands and equipment of the highest quality are available for use. The following information is for students preparing to audition.

General Requirements:

Stambaugh Youth Concert Band

- Student must be:
 - o A member in good standing of their high school instrumental music program
 - o In grades 9 through 12, consideration given to 8th graders
 - o Recommended by their high school band director

Enclosed is our permission form that we require all band directors to sign to confirm enrollment.

- Home school students must be recommended by private teacher
- Students are required to bring the signed permission form to their audition
- Students selected will follow all guidelines, rules, and regulations of SYCB
- Students selected are required to complete an online emergency contact form that can be found on stambaughauditorium.com/sycb
- Students becoming members of SYCB for the full year will be responsible for an \$100.00 fee for the year **due by Tuesday, October 22, 2024.**
 - o Unpaid fees will increase to \$125.00 after Tuesday, October 22nd
- Students becoming members of SYCB for the spring semester only will be responsible for a
 \$65.00 fee for the semester
- A required student/parent meeting will be held Tuesday, September 17, 2024, at 6:00 pm in the Concert Hall at Stambaugh Auditorium. The meeting is to discuss procedures and expectations for all students participating in SYCB

Jazz Ensemble

 Students interested in the rhythm section of the Jazz Ensemble do not need to participate in Stambaugh Youth Concert Band - all other instruments are required to participate in Stambaugh Youth Concert Band to participate in Jazz Ensemble



Audition Schedule:

- Wind Player & Percussion Auditions will be held Wednesday, September 4 from 5-9 pm and Tuesday, September 10 from 5-9 pm.
- During auditions, students can also audition for Jazz Band during the same time slot, but are required to participate in Stambaugh Youth Concert Band

Audition Materials and Information:

Stambaugh Youth Concert Band

- Musicians should prepare a segment with contrasting styles from a solo, not to exceed five minutes in length, at the OMEA Class C level minimum.
- Musicians will also be asked to sight read a short excerpt and sound tuning pitches.
- Appointments must be made to reserve an audition time. Please complete the link online at stambaughauditorium.com/sycb or call the Stambaugh Auditorium administrative office at 330-259-9651 if you have any questions.
- Please arrive at least 10 minutes early for your audition.
- Students should enter via the west entry doors (parking lot side of the building), will be checked in, and then go to the warmup area.
- Students will be called and directed to the audition space for their audition.

Jazz Ensemble

- Students can mark on their audition forms if they would like to be considered for Jazz
 Ensemble during their reserved SYCB audition time.
- If being considered, then they will be asked to sight-read 8 bars of music and to focus on stylistic choices.

General Guidelines:

- Most rehearsals will be at Stambaugh Auditorium, 1000 5th Avenue, Youngstown, OH 44504
 - o Jazz Band rehearsals are held every Tuesday unless otherwise noted from 5:00 pm -6:00 pm before SYCB. SYCB rehearsals are held every Tuesday unless otherwise noted from 6:00 pm 8:30 pm.
 - Parent meeting will be held on September 17 at 6:00 pm
- Uniformed Security will be present at all SYCB functions
- Students are required to attend all rehearsals and concerts of the SYCB
 - o Students are only allowed **2** absences
 - Excessive absences will be handled on a case by case basis
 - Work is **not** considered an excused absence



- If a conflict arises with respective school band activities, the student will honor their obligation to their high school band first. Please communicate in advance of any conflicts.
- Students are to have their music prepared for each rehearsal
- Band members will be given complete band information, calendar, and updated safety
 protocols at their first rehearsal. This information will also be available for download at
 stambaughauditorium.com/sycb.

Concert Dress Code

- Males
 - o WWhite long sleeve button up, long black tie, black dress pants, black belt, black dress socks, black dress shoes
- Females
 - o Black dress- mid-calf or ankle length, ¾ sleeves or long sleeves with a tasteful neckline
 - o Black slacks, black sweater or black blouse (¾ or long sleeves)
 - o Flats or 1 inch heel shoe with black socks or black pantyhose
